Become a Communication Major: The student must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.0. First-semester freshman and transfer students can declare without an established GPA and are required to obtain such at the end of their first semester.

Required Pre-requisites: All students must complete COMM 240 as a prerequisite to upper-level communication writing classes.

Program Completion: Students must pass with a grade of C (2.00) or better in all required courses for the communication degree program. To complete the degree, a total of 38 additional hours are required, **including a minor, second communication concentration, second major,** or other approved program and student-selected general electives. At least 30 hours taken at WCU must be at the junior-senior level to meet one of the general university degree requirements.
