Under the existing Articulation Agreement with the NCCC System, NC Community College graduates of an A.A. (Associate in Arts) or A.S. (Associate in Science) degree, will transfer into WCU with their Liberal Studies (along with the Upper Level Perspective) waived. Graduates with any other degree MUST satisfy the Liberal Studies program with either transfer credit or WCU courses.

Only work passed with a grade of C or better will be accepted for transfer. WCU course credits awarded through transfer cannot exceed the actual number earned credit hours in a course.
