Western Carolina University Emergency Notification Systems

RAVE

RAVE allows students, faculty, staff, and parents to receive voice, text, and email messages in case of emergency.

This is an opt-out" system, so all students, staff, and faculty are automatically entered into Rave. Please ensure that your Banner Emergency Contract information is correct to ensure that you receive alerts.

For parents, you can sign up for RAVE by registering at https://getrave.com/login/wcu LiveSafe Campus Mobile Safety App

This app pushes emergency notifications to students, staff, and faculty from the Rave system.

The app provides emergency action guidelines for multiple hazards, -æalsædechanism for information directly to the Emergency Communications Center using text, voice, and photos.

LiveSafe for Western Carolina University can be downloaded from the App Store or the Google Play Store.

Outdoor Siren System

The outdoor siren system alert means there is an emergency on campus, a potentially dangerous condition or an impending threat (i.e. severe weather, hazardous materials spill).

When the siren sounds, everyone on the WCU campus should take shelter indoors immediately. Close all windows and doors, if sibte, and remain sheltered until an "all clear" is given.

Alertus Computer Pop-up Emergency Notification

The Alertus computer desktop emergency notification system allows WCU Public Safety to send emergency notifications and updates directly to stafe they, and classroom computers during an emergency.

Campus Email

This system will send an email to the entire campus communityery student, faculty or staff member through their WCU mailbox.
