Eligibility and Nomination Process

Any full-time faculty member who has taught at Western Carolina University for at least one year may be nominated by a faculty member, department head, dean, or by self-nomination. Eligibility requires a minimum of <u>four</u> liberal studies courses/sections to have been taught at Western Carolina University prior to the semester in which nominations take place, as well as that they have not received this award in the preceding five years. Faculty members on scholarly leave are eligible but will still need to be observed in a teaching setting.
