Student Employment

- Remove ICA funded GAs and student stipends. Hire only externally funded GA ships.

- Reduce Professional Development. Apply for funding through Staff Senate scholarship, seek free and reduced online conferences and webinars.
- Some programs will become collaborations. We will reduce the amount of swag for Project CARE. Cost of student paid portion of Immersion Excursion will increase.
