OpenClipchamp and made an account: https://app.clipchamp.com/login Click orCreate a new video In the top left, click on Import Media and select your recorded lesson Drag the video down to the interist at the bottom Drag the two ends of the video to make the clip only encompass the part of the video you ne to keep for your clip (use the zoom in and out functions on the right to give you more detaile control over the start and end of your clip) Drag the whole clip back to the left to start at zero video to your computer.
