Award: The Invest in Teachers Award is a \$1,000 award available for the academic year (\$500 for the fall term, and \$500 for the spring term).

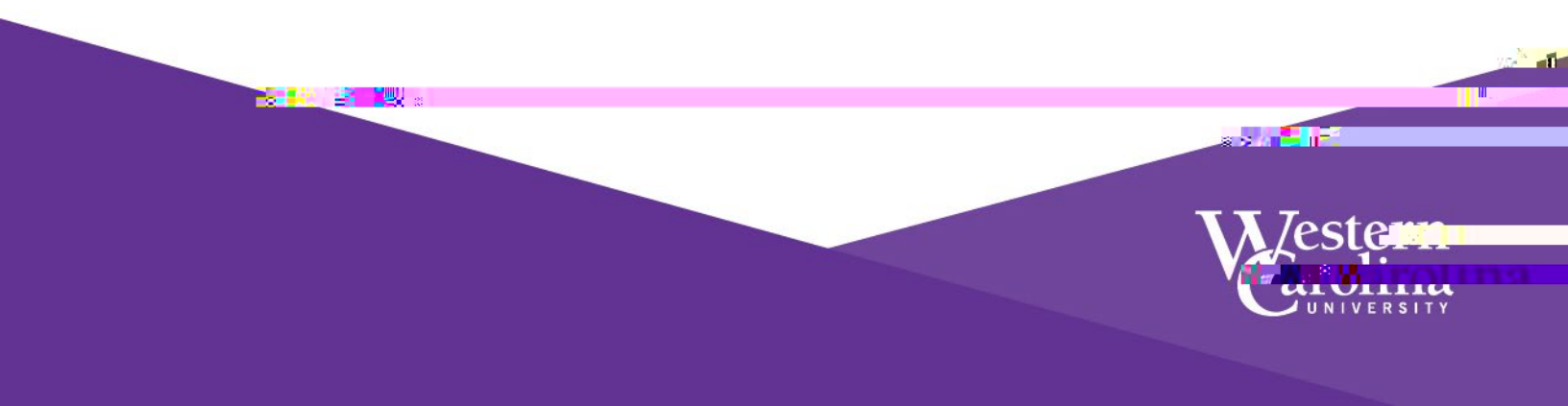
Eligibility

WCU is a TEACH Grant partner. The U.S. Department of Education's Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education Grant (TEACH) Program provides funds to students who are completing or who plan to complete coursework that is required to begin a career in teaching, and who agree to teach for at least four years as a highly qualified teacher at a school or education service agency (Serving low-income students in a high-need field). The four years of teaching must be completed within eight years after you complete or otherwise cease to be enrolled in the program for which you received a TEACH Grant.
